
EMBASSY THEATRE

HISTORY

- The Embassy was built in 1928.
 Originally named the Emboyd, it was by far the largest and grandest theater in Fort Wayne.
- In 1952 the name was changed to the Embassy Theatre when it was sold to the Alliance Amusement Corporation.
- Community members, led by Robert Goldstine, formed the nonprofit Embassy Theatre Foundation, Inc., in 1974. They succeeded in listing the Embassy on the National Register of Historic Places and in raising \$250,000 to purchase the building, saving it from destruction.
- A 1995 renovation brought the Embassy stage up to the modern standards required by large-scale touring companies. Restoration of the Indiana Hotel lobby also was completed at this time, contributing to the Embassy's reincarnation as a multi-use center for entertainment, social events and educational services.
- Completion of the \$10 million Vision for the Embassy renovation in 2016 expanded Embassy operations and revenues by putting the entire building to use for the first time in more than 40 years.

HOW IS MY MEMBERSHIP RECOGNIZED?


